Challenges in delivering support to the LDCs: stocktaking meeting highlights

Availability and provision of technical guidance and support in English only presents a barrier for non-English speakers;
The process of accessing funding from GCF for NAPs remains cumbersome for the LDCs;
There is less support for the implementation of NAPs;
Lack of data availability and appropriate tools for interpreting, analyzing and applying the data;
Heavy reporting burden to the LDCs due to increasing number of instruments (NCs, BURs, NAP, NDC, adaptation communication);

Purpose

- □ To mobilize the widest inputs from all interested and available actors and stakeholders to support countries in their work on NAPs;
- To test different approaches and dig deeper in various aspects and systems;

Achievements and plans

- Open NAP initiative for the LDCs in early stages on NAP work;
- Bottom-up evolution and development of the integrative framework for NAPs and the SDGs (NAP-SDG iFrame)



NAP articles, and publication

- □ To work with countries to author articles on their NAP outcomes, experience and lessons learned
- □ Launched in April 2019



Writing workshops for funding proposals

- Working with the GCF secretariat to conduct sessions focused on writing project proposals at NAP Expos
- □ To access funding for the implementation of policies, projects and programmes identified in NAPs



Paris Agreement training for the LDCs

To assist the LDCs on how to effectively and efficiently navigate and address the many elements of the Paris Agreement;
To coordinate and maximize synergy when implementing the Convention and the Paris Agreement;
