Overall Context



COP Decision **12/CP.25** para **21** – activities relevant to averting, minimizing, addressing LnD



Adoption of Strategic Plan 2024-2027, including 50:50 balance between mitigation and adaptation



Replenishment for GCF-2 (2024-2027) ongoing; pledging conference in October 2023



Activities relevant to Loss and Damage already under implementation as part of programming



Approaches presented are subject to discussions with GCF Board and incoming ED

COP Decision 12/CP.25 para 21

• "Continue providing financial resources for activities relevant to averting, minimizing and addressing loss and damage in developing countries to the extent consistent with the existing investment, results framework and funding windows and structures of the Green Climate Fund, and to facilitate efficient access in this regard, and in this context to take into account the strategic workstreams of the five year rolling workplan of the Executive Committee of the Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage associated with Climate Change Impacts"



Potential Approaches to Address Loss and Damage

- Strategic Plan for 2024-2027 does not set specific allocation parameters/ portfolio results targets for Loss and Damage.
- Board would need to consider how to operationalize any relevant COP/CMA guidance to scale up existing LnD activities
