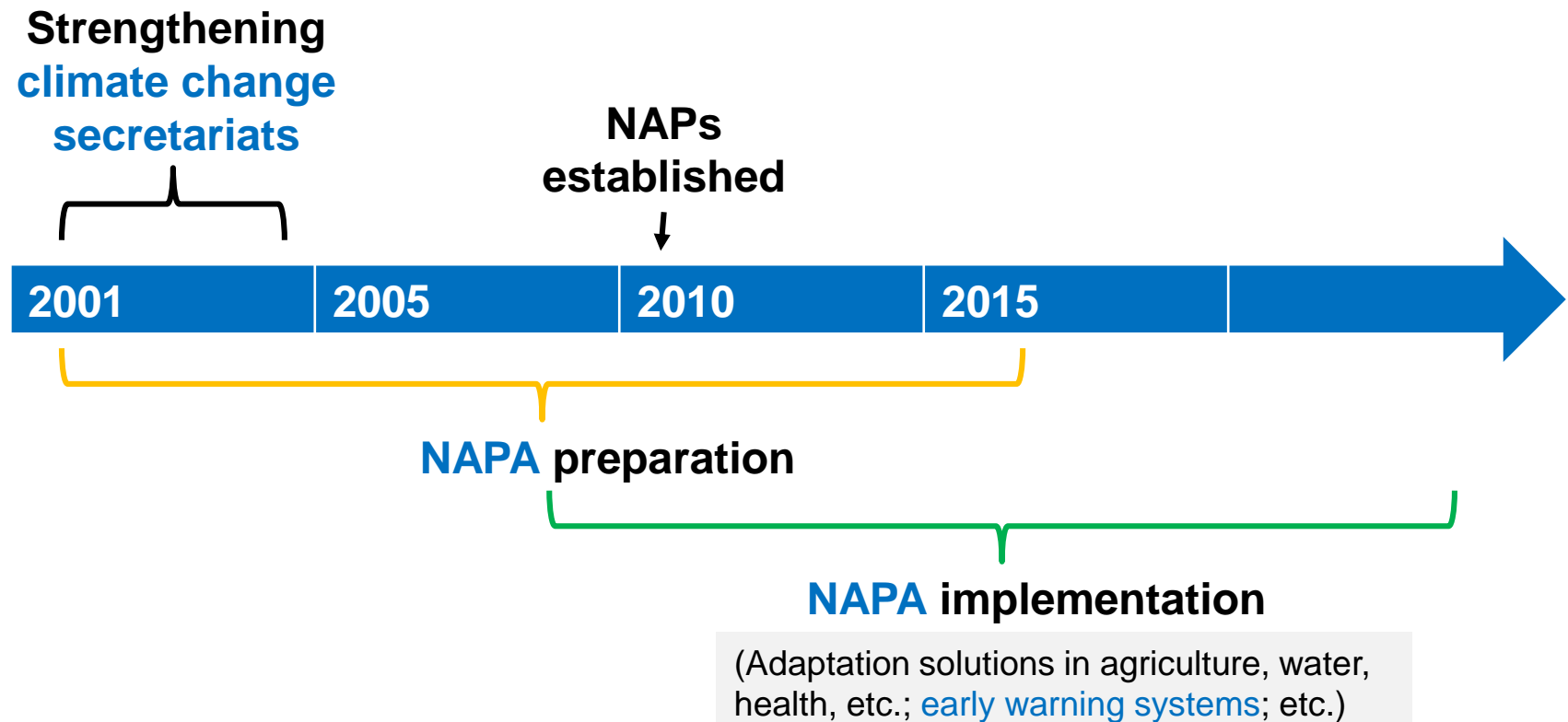

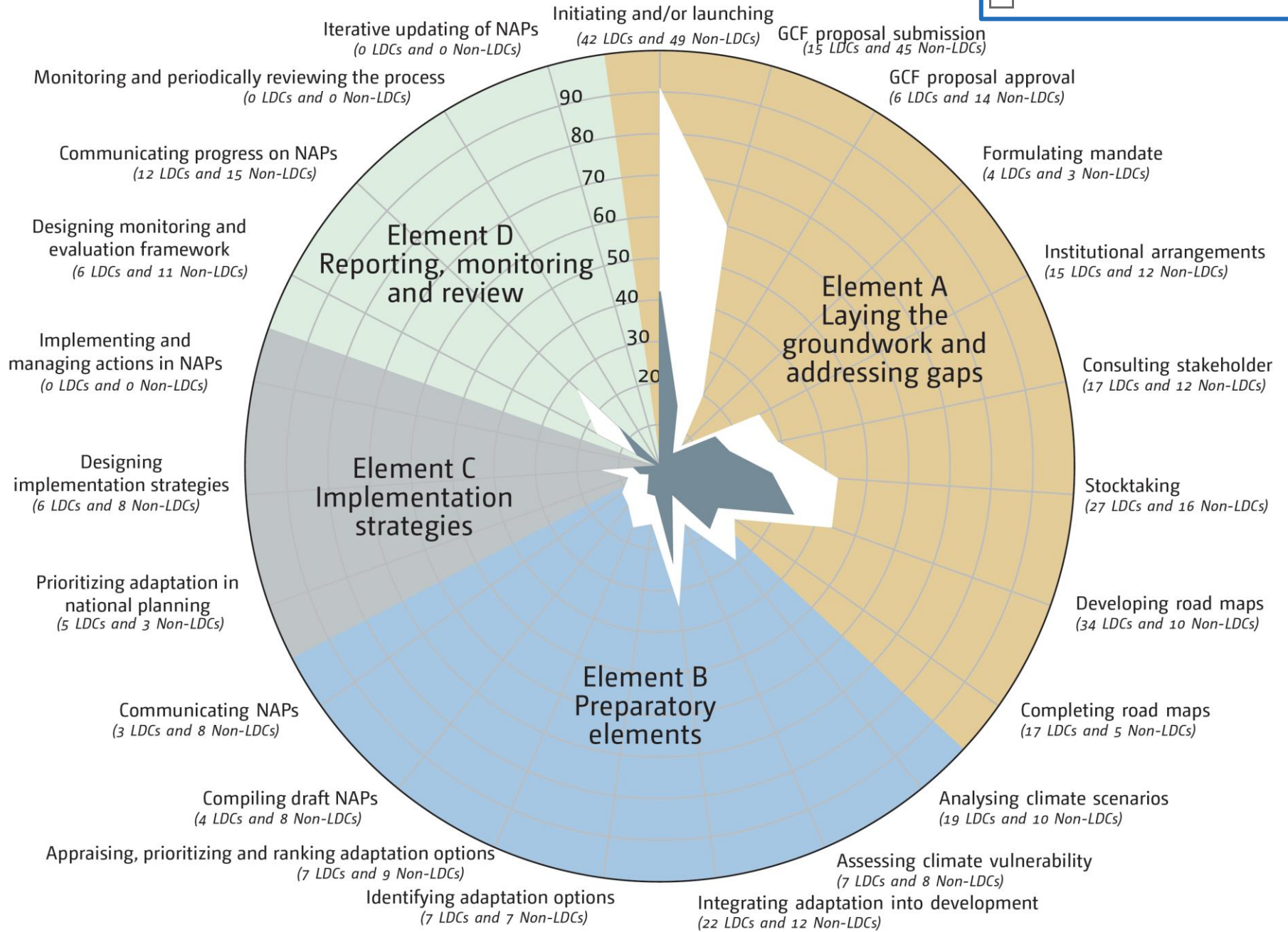

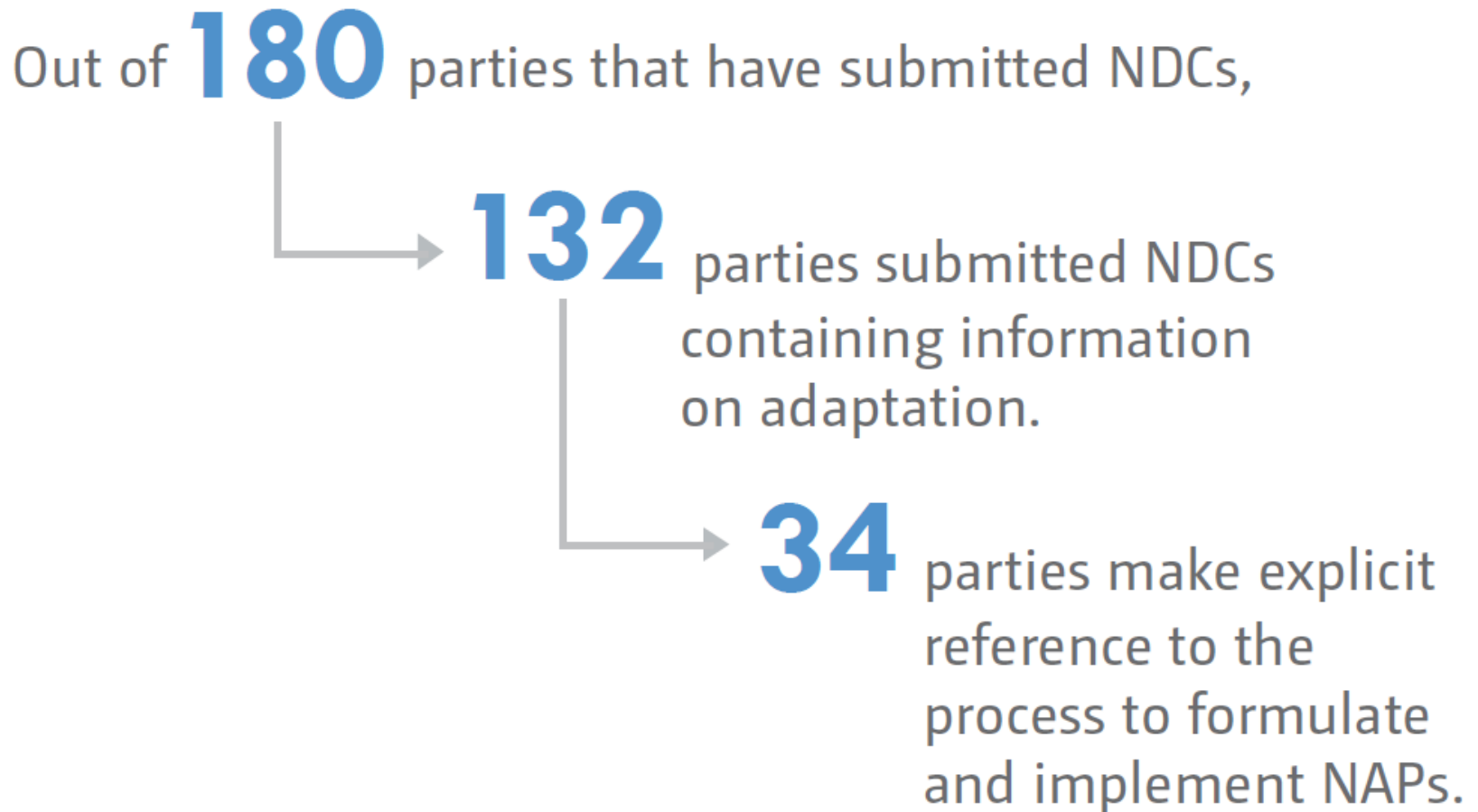


Progress the process formulate and implement NAPs
