



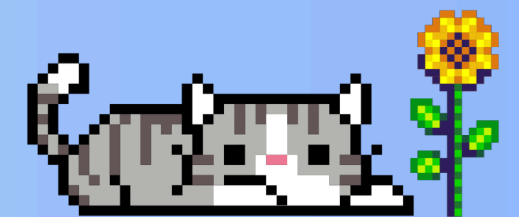

We are the official Children & Youth constituency and mechanism mandated to represent the voices of the children and youth NGOs in UNFCCC processes!



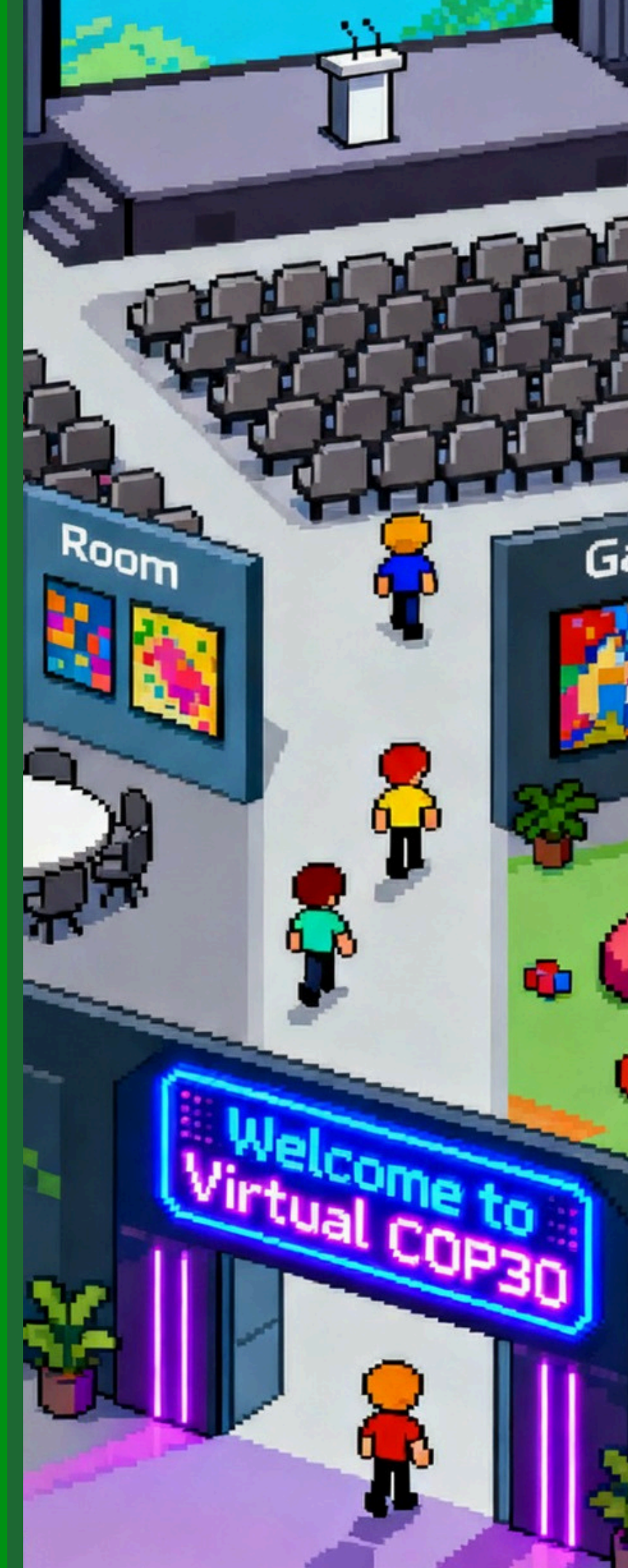
The **Energy Working Group**, composed of young energy experts from around the world, advocates for sustainable energy in COP negotiations and engages youth to shape a sustainable energy future.

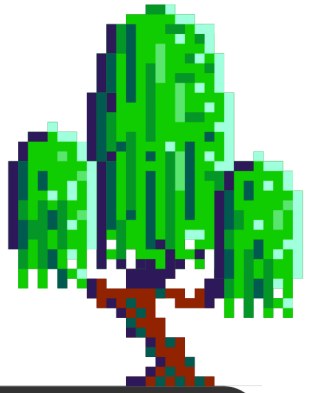

A 12-hour virtual conference replicating the UN COP experience, designed for those unable to attend COP30 in Belém.

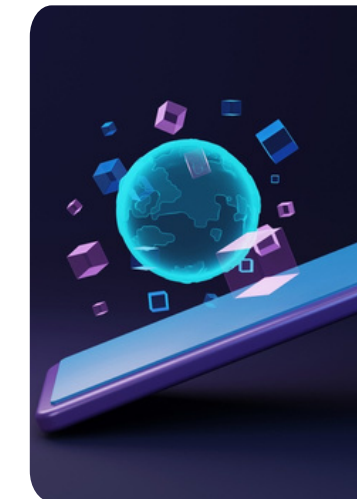

WHY?

The Virtual COP venue was intentionally designed to mirror the structure, flow, and exertion of a physical COP, ensuring that participants experienced not only the content of negotiations but also the process and atmosphere of being on site.

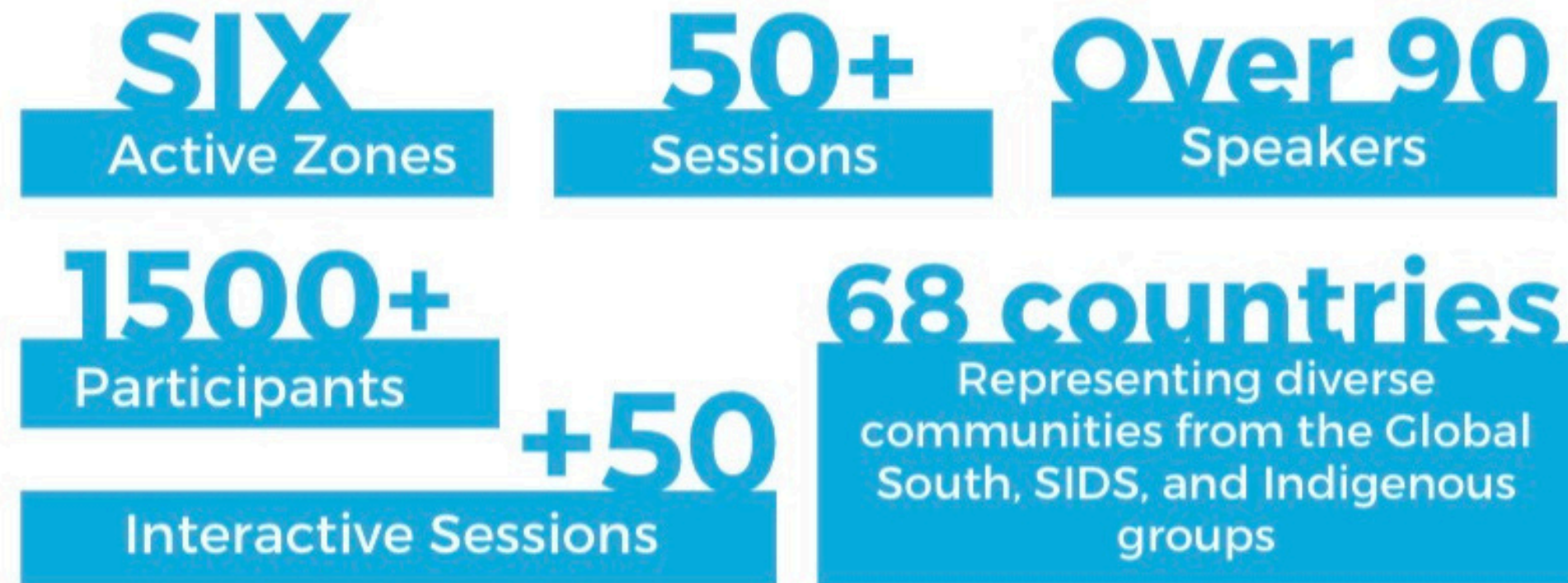
BUT

We ended up achieving way more than that!



The Virtual Conference of Parties (VCOP30), held on October 12, 2025, marked the first-ever Metaverse simulation of COP, designed and led entirely by youth under YOUNGO, the UNFCCC's official youth constituency.

Built around the principle of “**ACCESSIBILITY FOR ALL**”, VCOP30 redefined global climate engagement by creating a 12-hour 2-D metaverse digital event spanning all time zones and continents.



VCOP30 proved that climate action can transcend borders, demonstrating how digital platforms can serve as tools for empowerment, innovation, and equity.

The Pune Agreement University-Led Declaration for COP30

■ The Bombay Agreement

Youth-authored declaration endorsed by 26 countries, advocating equitable climate implementation, education, and digital inclusion.

- Adopted during VCOP30 (October 2025).
- Developed by: YOUNGO Energy WG, Policy & Negotiation Zone delegates.
- Endorsed by: 150+ organizations, youth networks, and academic institutions
- Aligned with COP30 Presidency's three pillars: Innovation, Implementation, Inclusion.

"The Bombay Agreement unites youth voices across **68 countries** to demand fast, fair, and inclusive implementation of the Paris Agreement."

University-Determined Contributions (UDCs)

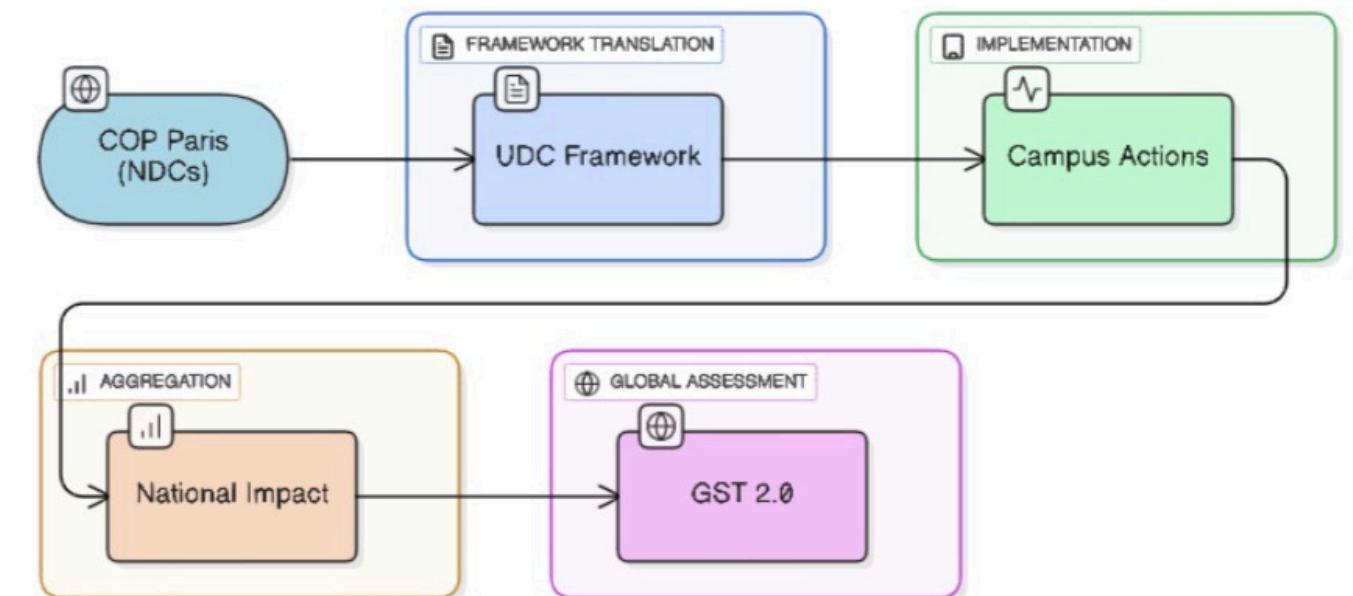
A Youth Mandate for Implementation

A first-of-its-kind model integrating academic research with national NDC commitments. 20+ universities pledged interest in pilot adoption.

- Modelled on the Paris Agreement's NDCs.
- Empowers universities worldwide to develop and submit climate roadmaps toward Net-Zero by 2030–2035.
- Converts campuses into living laboratories for climate solutions.
- Promotes experiential, project-based learning for youth climate leadership.

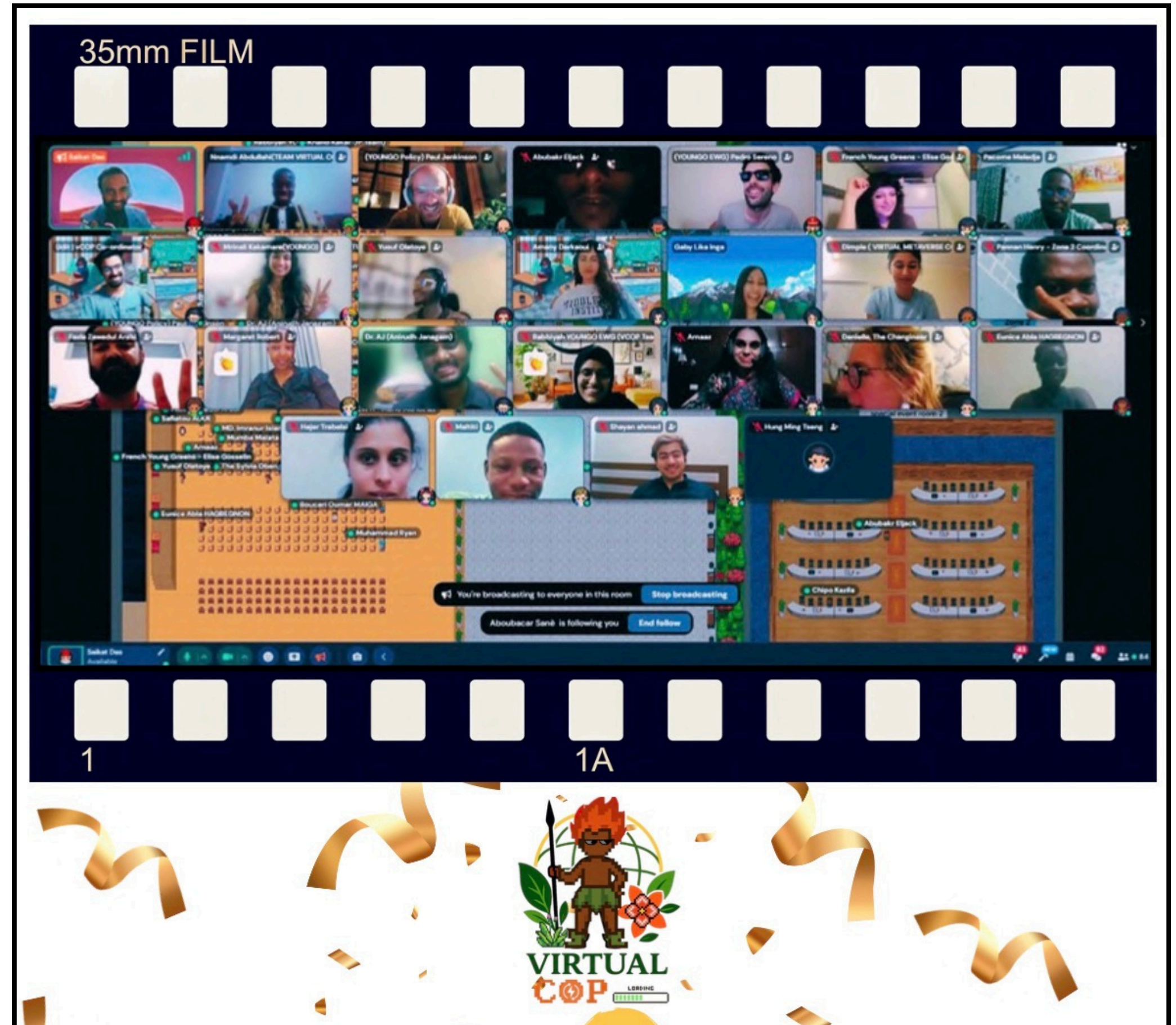

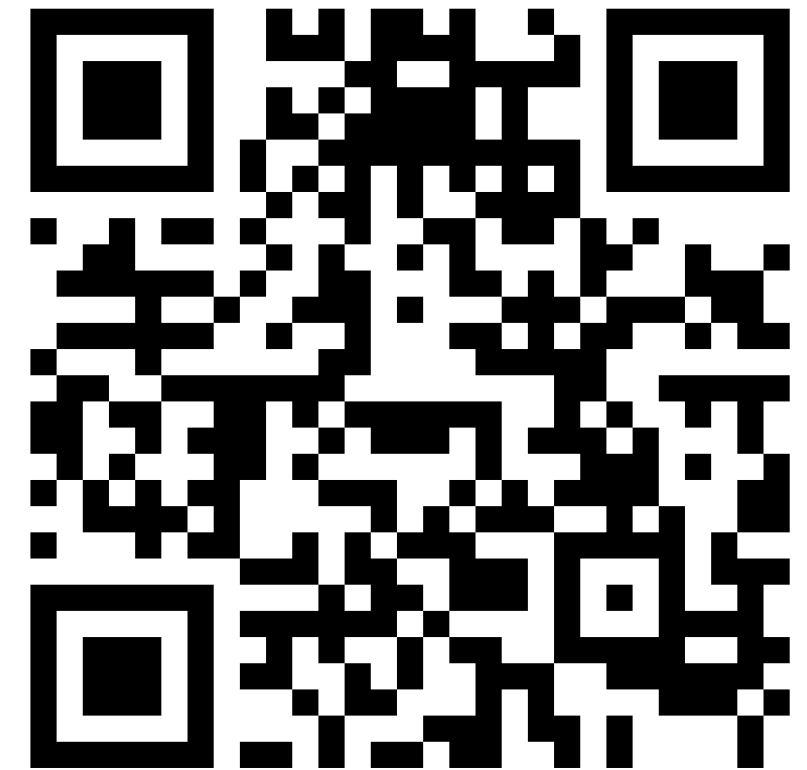

Event Overview

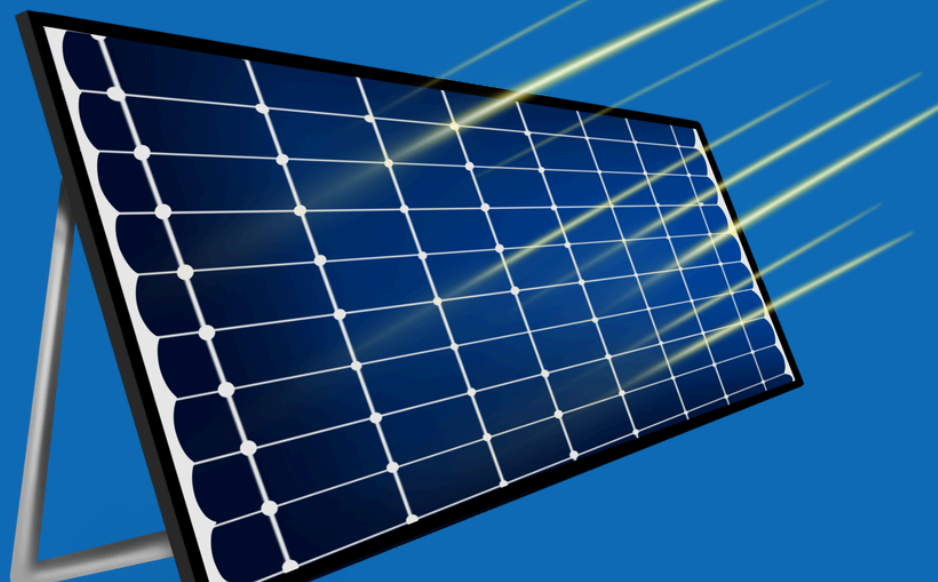
At a critical moment in the UK's energy transition, there is a clear gap: no dedicated Pre-COP clean energy high-level dialogue in London that convenes decision-makers across public, private, civil society, NGO, and UN communities.

That is exactly why the London Clean Energy Roundtable exists. This initiative addresses that gap by creating a unique, high-impact platform to shape UK energy policy for a just transition. As a result, discussions shaping the UK's energy future remain fragmented, limiting alignment, partnership creation, and the ability to influence a cohesive, investable policy direction.

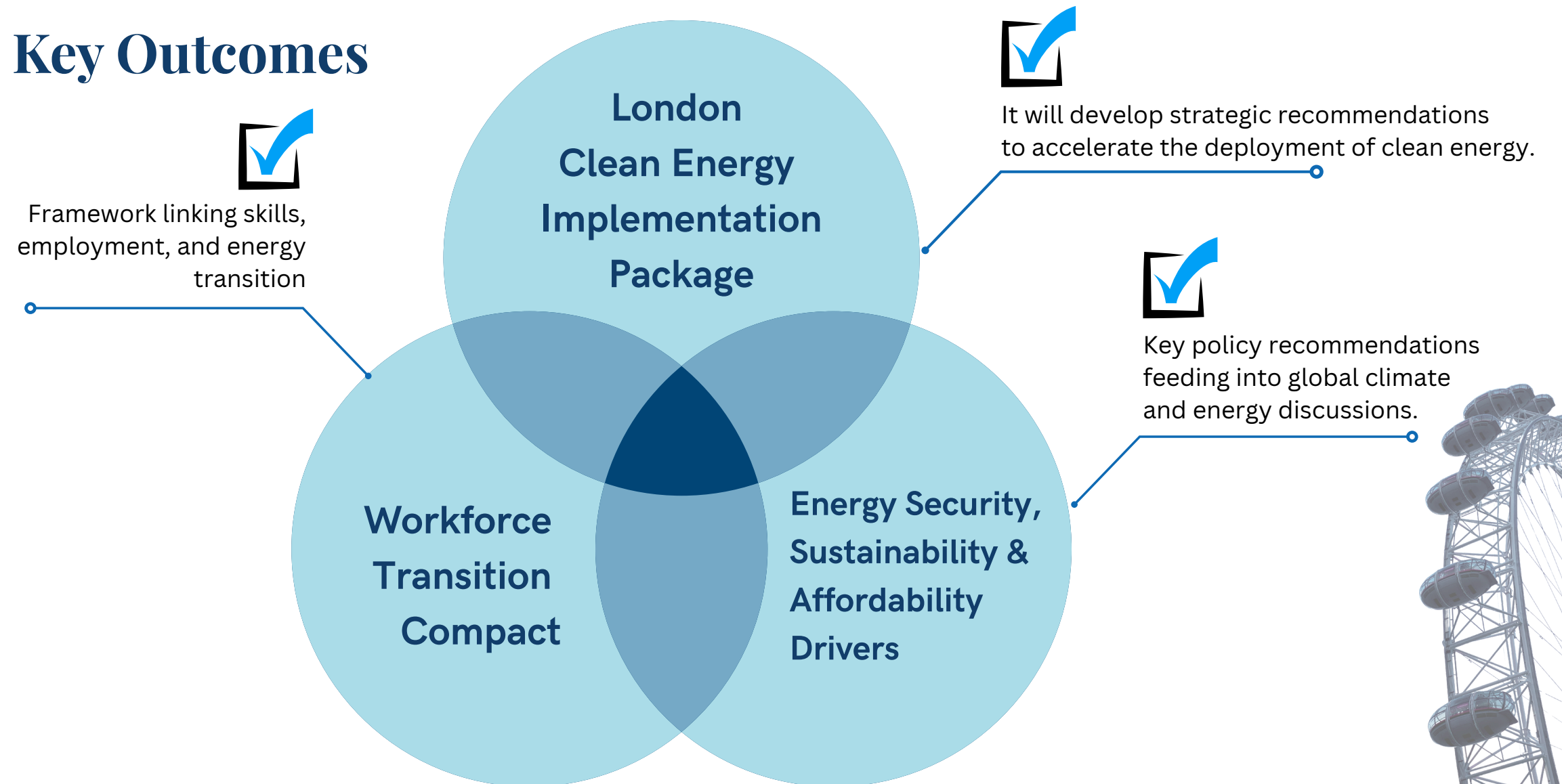

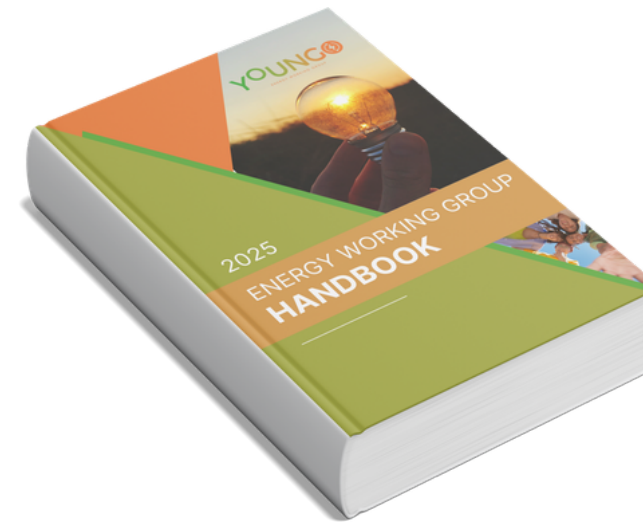

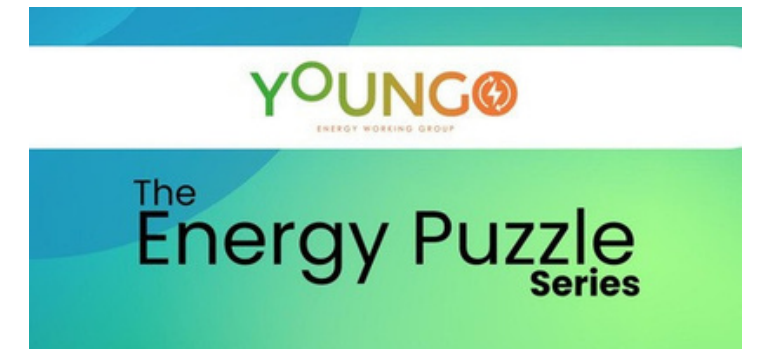
