"Yalla Let's Bike" (Come on Let's Bike) Initiative

Syria

In 2013, Sarah Zein began cycling to avoid the traffic congestion in Damascus, Syria. What should have been a normal bike ride to and from work was interrupted by verbal sexual harassment from bystanders. This motivated her to co-found "Yalla Let's Bike" (Come on Let's Bike), an initiative that aims to defy traditional gender roles, combat overcrowded streets, and promote cycling as a healthy and eco-friendly mode of transportation.

Key facts

- Over 4,000 girls and women have participated in "Yalla Let's Bike" cycling events;
- According to bike shop owners in Damascus, women and girls have made up 40% of buyers in the last two years;
- Bicycle sales have risen by 60% overall in the last few years in Damascus.
