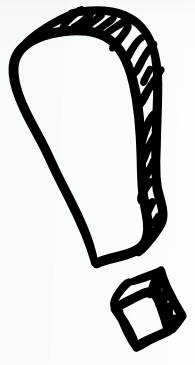


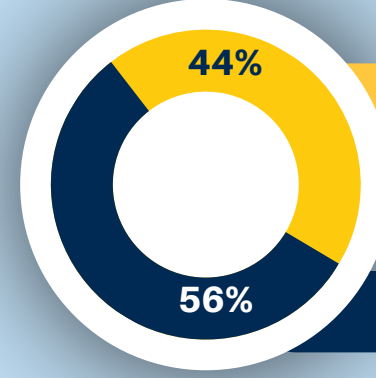
CLIMATE YOUTH NEGOTIATOR PROGRAMME

YNA has strong connections to the multilateral system but is unencumbered by its bureaucracy and hierarchies

EMPOWERING AND ACTIVATING YOUNG PEOPLE AS POSITIVE AGENTS OF CHANGE

- Developing young people's negotiation and leadership skills through a targeted capacity building training programme to become impactful and effective negotiators
- Embedding the community of youth negotiators into the wider ecosystem, recognising that global networks and productive professional relationships are crucial to foster inclusion and increase effectiveness.

DRIVING SYSTEMS CHANGE TO ENSURE LONG-TERM MEANINGFUL YOUTH LEADERSHIP IN DECISION-MAKING

- Tackling the existing substantial funding barriers that prevent young people from participating in negotiations through travel and subsistence grants
- Recognizing and valuing the contributions of young negotiators in decision-making processes through targeted advocacy and outreach to achieve a change in decision-makers' values and a resilient society.

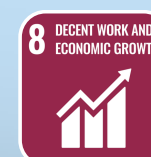
