BACKGROUND

The Global stocktake (GST) assesses collective progress towards the purpose and long-term goals of the Paris Agreement in a comprehensive and facilitative manner, considering mitigation, adaptation and the means of implementation and support (MOI), in the light of equity and the best available science. The GST will also consider the social and economic consequences of response measures and efforts to address loss and damage

The GST is an inclusive Party-driven process with the participation of all stakeholders.

THE EVENT

This GST event is an opportunity to engage governments and civil society in the GST process. It will provide information on opportunities to participate in the GST and emphasize the importance of the GST as a mechanism to increase ambition and foster climate action at all levels.

The session also provides space to hold conversations on the themes of the GST – mitigation, adaptation, means of implementation, as well as response measures and loss and damage – and an opportunity to discuss possible inputs at the regional level, including on the collective progress to date, challenges and barriers to achieve the Paris Agreement goals, and directions to enhance climate action and ambition, highlighting effective and innovative solutions in the region.
