### **SCF agreed to:**

  - a) Discuss with Parties and constituted bodies intersessionally and facilitate improvements to the quality and clarity of draft guidance submissions;
  - b) Organize webinars with the operating entities to assist Parties in preparing draft guidance submissions and inform on outcomes of relevant Board meetings;
  - c) Enhance tools to facilitate Parties' preparation of draft guidance submissions, including an updated booklet of previous guidance to the OEs, a compilation of OEs' reported responses to guidance and an updated submission template.
3. Co-facilitators will prepare a thematically clustered compilation of submissions for consideration at SCF 41.
