

1. Supervisory Body workplan 2023

1. Procedural background

1. The Supervisory Body, at its fourth meeting, approved the workplan of the Body for 2023 and requested the secretariat to provide an update of it at each meeting.

2. Purpose

2. The workplan of the Supervisory Body for 2023 provides an overview of the issues to be considered by the Body at each meeting during the year and identifies concrete activities arising from the mandates from the CMA. This allows the Body to plan its work throughout the year, ensuring a balanced workload and an efficient use of meeting time.

3. Key issues and proposed solutions

3. The workplan provides information regarding products to be considered by the Supervisory Body at each meeting. The product stage included in the workplan indicates the action to be taken by the Supervisory Body as indicated in table 1 below:

- 4. Table 2 below provides an overview of the workplan of the Article 6.4 Supervisory Body for 2023. Changes to the previous version of the workplan are highlighted and the reference to the decision of the Supervisory Body or CMA is also provided in the document.
