- ✓ Coherence and coordination. What would effective capacity building look like, in particular for vulnerable groups and regions such as small islands and Africa?
- ✓ Challenging data availability. How could better data management, more informed policymaking and capacity-building be stimulated?
- ✓ The process to formulate and implement NAPs can effectively support the
 implementation of enhanced adaptation action and the development of
 integrated approaches to adaptation, sustainable development and disaster
 risk reduction. What are your experiences?
