I: Introduction and background

- ❖ As per Article 14, paragraph 1, of the Paris Agreement, the CMA shall periodically take stock of the implementation of the Paris Agreement to assess the collective progress towards achieving the purpose of the Agreement and its long-term goals, and shall do so in a comprehensive and facilitative manner, considering mitigation, adaptation and the means of implementation and support, and in the light of equity and the best available science.
- ❖ The CMA by its decision 19/CMA.1, para 24, invited the relevant constituted bodies and forums and other institutional arrangements under or serving the Paris Agreement and/or the Convention to prepare for the technical assessment, with the assistance of the secretariat, synthesis reports to be completed in February/March 2022.

- ❖ The AC continued the consideration of the annotated outline and coordination with other CBs on the matter
- ❖ The annotated outline has been revised to implement the comments by the AC at its 19th meeting
- ❖ Liaised with the LEG, the ExCom, LCIPP, SCF, TEC, PCCB, CGE and KCI to gather information on what reports other bodies are planning to produce in response to the mandate
