Technologies for adaptation

- In its 2019-2021 flexible workplan, the AC agreed to prepare, in 2021, a technical paper on the application of technologies for an adaptation priority topic and to determine the topic and prepare a scoping note in the second half of 2020.
- ✤ AC 18 considered and agreed on the topic:
 - "Priorities and needs: technologies for adaptation in agriculture, water resources and coastal zones; including experiences in stakeholder engagement and regulatory issues pertaining to the development, transfer and uptake of technologies in those sectors"
- AC 19 further agreed on the objective, scope, and annotated outline of the technical paper.



- The draft technical paper (AC20/TP/7B) has been developed based on this agreed annotated outline, objective, and scope.
- It includes two main substantive chapters focusing on adaptation technologies for agriculture, water, and coastal zones, one from the perspective of adaptation planning and one from the perspective of implementation.
 - Sub-themes include technology transfer, stakeholder engagement, regulatory issues, innovative approaches, and good practices, and good practices, gaps, needs, and challenges.



- The current draft is a work-in-progress, with placeholders indicating how it will develop further in the next iteration.
- Among other things, the next iteration will:
 - Integrate further research materials;
 - Incorporate quantitative analyses and insights;
 - Integrate further case studies, ensuring regional balance;
 - Include sections on indigenous knowledge/technologies and gender-sensitive and -responsive approaches;
 - Refine the figures;
 - Complete sections now represented by placeholders; and
 - Incorporate insights from relevant upcoming events.



- The AC may wish to:
 - Provide its feedback on this first, work-in-progress draft of the technical paper;
 - Engage with the TEC, CTCN and NAP Task Force to refine and finalize the paper ahead of AC21; and
 - Consider how to reflect any potential follow-up work in the draft 2022-2024 workplan.
