## I: Mandate and objective

---

- ❖ Decision 2/CP.26: "Parties to identify one or more adaptation contact points through their UNFCCC NFPs with a view to enhancing the dissemination of information between Parties and the AC, the LEG, as well as other relevant organizations and programme partners, such as partners of the Nairobi work programme on impacts, including on Parties' efforts to formulate and implement NAPs"
- ❖ Scope for the engagement of adaptation contact points is also addressed in the outcomes of SBSTA 52-55 relating to the NWP
- ❖ This is a mandate to the secretariat, but views from the AC will be valuable
