## I: Introduction and background

---

- ❖ The CMA requested the secretariat, under the guidance of the AC and the LEG and in collaboration with relevant stakeholders, to prepare synthesis reports every two years starting in 2020 on specific adaptation themes – focusing on relevant lessons and good practices in developing country Parties
- ❖ In the context of the CMA's consideration of recognizing adaptation efforts of developing country Parties (Decision 11/CMA.1, para. 13)
- ❖ In 2020 the AC developed the first report on “*How developing countries are addressing hazards*”
- ❖ At AC 19 the AC agreed on the theme for the second report as “*Assessing and meeting the costs of adaptation*”
- ❖ At AC 20 the AC agreed on the broad outline of the report and requested the secretariat to prepare a first draft for consideration at AC 21



## II: Overview

---

- ❖ The draft annotated outline of the 2022 synthesis report contains the following elements:
  - Summary (key graphics, results);
  - Introduction and background (background, objectives, outline, methodological issues with the costs of adaptation);
  - Assessing the costs of adaptation (existing methods, estimates of costs, experiences);
  - Meeting the costs of adaptation (domestic expenditure, enabling environments, overall experience);
  - Key findings, experiences and insights.
