Adaptation Communications

Draft supplementary guidance for voluntary use by Parties in communicating information in accordance with the possible elements of an adaptation communication

6-9 September 2022

I. Introduction and background

- Mandate: In 2018, the CMA requested the AC to develop, with the engagement of the IPCC WGII, using relevant existing guidance as a starting point, by June 2022, draft supplementary guidance for voluntary use by Parties in communicating information in accordance with the elements contained in the annex of decision 9/CMA.1 for consideration by the subsidiary bodies at their fifty-seventh sessions (Nov. 2022)
- **Objective**: To help Parties enhance the quality of information, reduce duplications and efforts required to prepare that information, and allow them to benefit from synergies with relevant efforts
- Approach: Collection of feedback provided by Party representatives, practitioners, and other experts, including scientific experts from IPCC WG II, e.g. 30 June 2021, Webinar; 22 March 2022, Expert meeting and continuous guidance by the AC
