I. Background

- ❖ The AC requested the secretariat to prepare a **map of mandates, workplans and/or decisions with adaptation relevance** under the Convention after each session of the Conference of the Parties.
- ❖ That overview is used to compare, analyse and consider what actions may need to be undertaken by the AC to enhance coherence.
- ❖ The AC is in regular contact with the other **adaptation-related constituted bodies to discuss collaborative opportunities**, particularly during the the yearly Dialogue.

II. Mandates and concrete opportunities of collaborative work

- ❖ Updated information based on the **outcomes of COP 27 and CMA 4** is contained in document AC23/INFO/5A.
- ❖ Document AC23/INFO/5A also contains information on **collaborative activities with other constituted bodies** carried out since the last meeting, and **concrete proposals for further work** based on mandates and past conversations between the AC and other constituted bodies, as well as opportunities of work related to relevant workstreams under the UNFCCC and the Paris Agreement.

IV. Next steps

❖ The AC is invited to:

- Consider document AC23/INFO/5A, in particular the sections on concrete opportunities, with a view to agreeing on any action, as required.
- Request the secretariat to follow up on the agreements found at AC 23 and to initiate work in the intersessional period.
