# I. Introduction and background

---

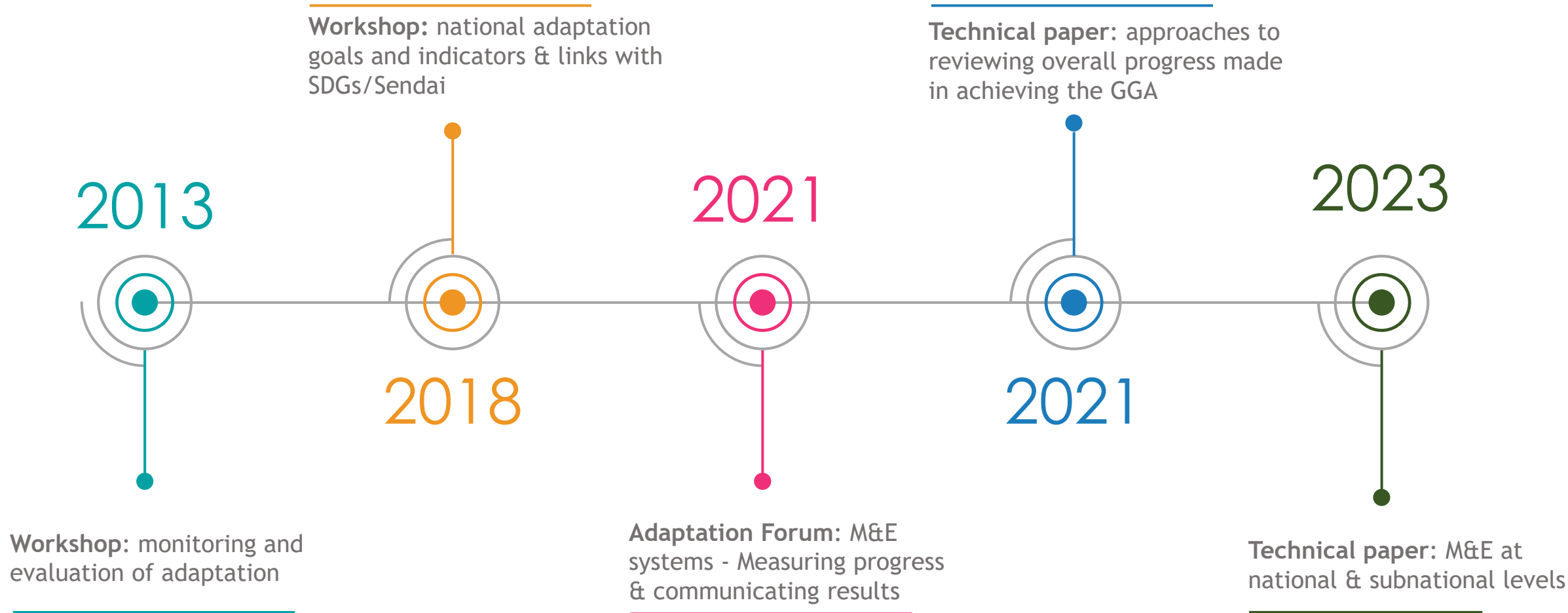
- **2022-2024 workplan:** AC agreed to prepare a technical paper featuring case studies on the development and application of monitoring and evaluation (M&E) systems at the national and subnational level
- **AC21:** AC agreed outline for the paper and a range of considerations to guide its preparation
- **30 June 2022:** Deadline for submissions of case studies related to national and subnational M&E systems for adaptation
- **Pre-AC 22 (19 August):** AC members considered a first draft in an intersessional conference call
- **AC 22:** AC members further considered the first draft and provided additional guidance

## II. Key changes

---

- Since AC22, key changes to the draft include:
  - ❖ Key questions clearly articulated;
  - ❖ General information on adaptation M&E methodologies and approaches added to chapter two, including two new graphics;
  - ❖ Discussion chapter restructured, with main findings presented in a new table;
  - ❖ Recommendations added based on the key findings.

- Provide additional guidance for finalizing the substance of the paper following AC23;

- Identify other follow-up activities and associated partners, if desired, taking into account possible linkages with work being undertaken in related areas, including the global stocktake and the global goal on adaptation.
