Opportunities for collaboration with other Constituted Bodies, including from the outcomes of COP 28/CMA 5

I. Introduction and background

- ❖ Collaboration with other adaptation-related institutional arrangements is a key element of the AC's work in promoting coherent action on adaptation under the Convention and the Paris Agreement.
- ❖ As part of the outcome of the first global stocktake, decision 1/CMA.4, para. 186, invited the relevant work programmes and constituted bodies under or serving the Paris Agreement to integrate relevant outcomes of the first global stocktake in planning their future work, in line with their mandates.

II. Next steps

- ❖ Representatives of the adaptation-related constituted bodies are invited to inform the meeting on the progress of the adaptation-related work they are undertaking and flag any opportunities for collaboration for consideration, including from the outcomes of COP 28/CMA 5, as appropriate.

III. Guiding questions

- How can constituted bodies' existing activities and workstreams be made to align with the GST1 outcomes related to adaptation?
- How can constituted bodies ensure that their subsequent workplans are developed and implemented in line with the GST1 outcomes?
- What activities have constituted bodies already planned to fulfil their specific mandates from decision 1/CMA.5?
- What are opportunities for collaboration among different constituted bodies in this regard?
