I. Introduction and background

- ❖ The CMA > prepare synthesis reports every two years starting in 2020.
 - ❖ Focus on **relevant lessons learned and good practices** in developing country Parties.
- ❖ The AC prepared two synthesis reports in this context:
 1. How developing countries are addressing hazards, focusing on relevant lessons learned and good practices (2020)
 2. How developing countries are assessing and meeting the costs of adaptation (2022)
- ❖ AC 24 > focus the 2024 report on institutional arrangements and stakeholder engagement.
- ❖ WG > revised outline of the report with comments received at AC 24.

II. Revised draft outline

- Introduction
- Short overview on the roles and main benefits of effective institutional arrangements and stakeholder engagement for adaptation planning and implementation
- Efforts of developing country Parties in setting up institutional arrangements and in engaging stakeholders (beneficiaries, research institutions, NGOs, representatives of different sectors and disciplines, private sector, particularly vulnerable groups, including indigenous peoples), including case studies
 - ❖ at different levels of government, including national, sub-national, sectoral, regional, including examples of South-South collaboration; and
 - ❖ for the different components of the adaptation cycle, including risk impacts assessment, planning, implementation, monitoring, evaluation and learning.
- ❖ Lessons learned and good practices in setting up and maintaining effective institutional arrangements and stakeholder engagement.

IV. Next steps – the AC may wish to...

- ❖ Consider the revised outline for its 2024 synthesis report and to take the following next steps
 - Prepare an annotated outline for intersessional consideration by the AC and a timeline for the information collection process (April/May)
 - Prepare a first draft of the synthesis report for consideration by AC 26 (September)
 - Prepare final draft for intersessional consideration by the AC (October)
- ❖ Contributions from NWP partners and regional collaboration centres > complement the sources of information envisioned to be used for the report.
