II. Opportunities at COP29/CMA6 on Baku

- To continue collaboration on the PCCB's 2024 theme of “Capacity-building for addressing gaps and needs for accessing finance for NAPs,” the PCCB extended an invitation to the AC to collaborate to the thematic day on this topic during the 2024 Capacity Building Hub.
- The NAP Global Network submitted an expression of interest to hold an event during the Capacity Building Hub to further support the dissemination of the AC/NAP GN *Toolkit for Monitoring, Evaluation, and Learning for NAP Processes*, and to discuss how it can be useful in line with the UAE Framework on Global Climate Resilience and the UAE-Belem Work Programme.

II. Opportunities at COP29/CMA6 on Baku II

- The AC may wish to consider launching relevant deliverables at COP29/CMA6 for 2024 including, for example:
 - the State of Adaptation Action by Parties: Interactive portal of country profiles;
 - the new publication on *30 years of Adaptation - From the Convention to the Paris Agreement and beyond*; and
 - the *policy brief on progress, good practices and lessons learned, challenges and opportunities in the application of traditional knowledge, knowledge of indigenous peoples and local knowledge systems in adaptation.*
