CONTEXT

- **Drives country- and region-specific action** among diverse stakeholders (thematic expert groups, constituted bodies and regional networks, organizations and communities of practice)
- **Focuses on creating, cultivating and curating knowledge and know-how** to build climate resilience of communities
- **Opportunities** to shape the future of adaptation knowledge systems in response to evolving adaptation and resilience landscape



COLLABORATION WITH THE ADAPTATION COMMITTEE

- Monitoring, evaluation and learning:
 - Space for exchange, including on AC's ongoing work
 - Leveraging experts from the NWP network + others
- Next steps
 - Continuing engagement with diverse group of stakeholders (AC, LEG, MEL experts) to facilitate the exchange of best practices, tools and methodologies (such as use of innovative technologies such as AI and machine learning systems), including for transformational adaptation

OTHER ELEMENTS OF WORK IN RESPONSE TO THE ADVICE FROM THE ADAPTATION COMMITTEE

- Regional work
 - Mountains and climate change
 - facilitating knowledge exchange on mountains and climate change*
 - Strengthening partnerships with diverse stakeholders
 - LAKI
 - co-creating and sharing knowledge in subregions under the LAKI (first series of the case studies will be published soon)
 - Proposed next steps
 - co-creating context-specific insights and know-how with expert group on mountains, addressing the transboundary nature of climate change impacts and risks

- **Providing knowledge/know-how support to the constituted bodies in implementing the work plans (AC, LEG, TEC, FWG,)**
- **Facilitating knowledge exchange to contribute to UAE framework on Global Climate Resilience**
- **Co-creating, cultivating and curating knowledge and know-how on topics/thematic areas: MEL, mountains and climate change, others**
- **Strengthening regional and transboundary cooperation (LAKI, mountains)**
