- Impact, vulnerability, and risk assessments are foundational for effective adaptation
- Common challenges in developing countries:
 - > Institutional capacity constraints
 - Data gaps and quality issues
 - > Weak integration into policy processes



IV. Technical scope of work

- Ensure regional balance and address multiple governance levels
- Focus on institutional capacity-building
- Key priorities:
 - ✓ Methodological review
 - ✓ Data access and sharing
 - Use of assessments in decision-making



V. Modalities for implementation

- Case studies: Capture tools, practices, and lessons
- Technical paper: Synthesize methodologies and assess relevance and coherence
- Expert meetings: Gather technical inputs
- Virtual consultations: Enable broader participation
- Capacity-building workshop: Facilitate learning and exchange
