Navigating the landscape of support for NAPs - 2025 update

Bonn, Germany

15–19 September 2025





I. Introduction and background

- As part of its 2025–2027 flexible workplan, the AC decided to periodically update the online resource on navigating the landscape of support for NAPs
- AC 27 decided to seek further feedback on the concept note, continue considering how to engage external expertise and present the 2022 version of the online resource at the 2025 NAP Expo for feedback
- At its mid-term call, the AC agreed on a draft list of external experts and organizations to be engaged and requested the secretariat to provide two options for the finance section for consideration at AC 28



II. Feedback from the NAP Expo session

- Much needed tool to facilitate the navigation of an increasingly complex landscape

Recommendations for the planned update:

- **Forms of knowledge:** include all forms of knowledge
- **Scope:** information for all levels, focus on implementation and MEL, more information on all sources and channels of finance, peer experience, option to dynamically submit new available support, option to interact with experts/support providers
- **Target audience:** all levels, support providers and recipients



II. Feedback from the NAP Expo session (cont.)

- **Structure and functionality:** current structure plus option to tag/filter by adaptation cycle element, options for filtering, searching and tagging, dynamic updates, different languages, user account => matchmaking platform
- **Complementarity:** Interlinkages with other existing platforms



III. Proposed modular approach to the update

Phase 1 – 2025

- Updated 2022 data
- Support available for adaptation planning and implementation in line with thematic targets
- Support available for adaptation planning and implementation in line with dimensional targets
- Support available for incorporating cross-cutting considerations
- Option 1 or 2 for finance section
- Available regional support
- Layer for information on country needs and exchange of experience (link to SoA portal)



III. Proposed modular approach to the update (cont.)

Phase 2 – 2026

- Interactive modules for each category of support, including tagging and filtering options for different user categories and needs
- Interlinkages with other platforms
- Translation tool

Phase 3 – 2026/2027 (subject to available resources)

- Additional interactive functionalities, e.g. AI tools allowing for dynamic updates, chatbot functions, creation of user accounts



IV. Options for finance section

Option 1

- Keep scope of the 2022 version and update data

Option 2

- Add support available for enhancing countries' capacities to access all sources of adaptation finance – e.g. support for assessing adaptation costs, conducting economic analyses, direct access, development of adaptation investment strategies, formulation of project and programme proposals, resource mobilization strategies



V. External engagement

As agreed during mid-term call:

- Organizations and entities featured in the 2022 version
- UNFCCC Regional Collaboration Centres
- Option 1: Selected experts that have assisted in the technical work under the UAE–Belém work programme on indicators
- Option 2: Selected lead organizations for each UAE Framework’s thematic area
- NAP TF for peer reviewing the received proposals from external experts and organizations and for sharing additional input to the update, as appropriate



VI. Next steps

The AC may wish to

- Endorse the elements included in phase 1 of the proposed modular approach to the update and the respective outline, including either option 1 or 2 of the finance section, and request the secretariat to develop the draft update on that basis (October 2025);
- Request the secretariat to invite inputs from the agreed groups of external experts and organizations, including option 1 or option 2 for the experts on support for the UAE Framework's thematic targets (October 2025);
- Request the secretariat to invite the NAP TF to review the first draft, including the inputs received from external experts and organizations, and provide additional inputs, as appropriate (October/November 2025);



VI. Next steps (cont.)

- Request the secretariat to finalize the first draft of the updated online resource, taking into account the inputs received, and share it for the AC's intersessional consideration (end of November 2025);
- Request the secretariat to finalize phase 1 of the update, taking into account any further guidance provided by the AC (December 2025);
- Request the secretariat to prepare concept notes for phase 2 and 3 of the modular update for the AC's consideration at its 29th meeting.
