## **CALL FOR NOMINATIONS**

### **Call for nominations of loss and damage contact points**

By decision 4/CP.22, COP 22 invited interested Parties to establish a loss and damage contact point through their respective UNFCCC national focal point with a view to enhancing the implementation of approaches to address loss and damage associated with the adverse impacts of climate change at the national level.

Subsequently, by decision 5/CP.23, COP 23 encouraged Parties to actively engage in the work and to disseminate, promote and make use of the products of the Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage associated with Climate Change Impacts and its Executive Committee, including by establishing a loss and damage contact point through their respective UNFCCC national focal point.

To date, 25 Parties have communicated their nominations of loss and damage contact points to the secretariat. Loss and damage contact points, alongside other relevant channels, can play an important role in raising awareness of, and enhancing coordination, action and support for, averting, minimizing and addressing loss and damage associated with the adverse effects of climate change.

We look forward to receiving nominations of loss and damage contact points from interested Parties that have not yet communicated such information to the secretariat.
