I. Introduction

1. After consultations with Parties by the incoming Presidency of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement (CMA) at its fourth session, the Executive Secretary, in agreement with the Presidency of CMA 3, prepared the provisional agenda for CMA 4 below.

II. Supplementary provisional agenda

- 2. The supplementary provisional agenda for CMA 4, proposed after consultation with the President of CMA 3, is as follows:
 - 1. Opening of the session.

 - (a) Adoption of the agenda;
 - (b) Election of additional officers;

 - (d) Approval of the report on credentials.

 - (b) Report of the Subsidiary Body for Implementation.
