## Draft report of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement on its fourth session

## I. Opening of the session

(Agenda item 1)

1. The fourth session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement (CMA), convened pursuant to Article 16, paragraph 6, of the Paris Agreement, was held at the Sharm el-Sheikh International Convention Center in Sharm el-Sheikh, Egypt, from 6 to 18 November 2022. Sameh Shoukry (Egypt), President of CMA 4, convened the 1<sup>st</sup> meeting of the session<sup>1</sup> on Sunday, 6 November.<sup>2</sup>

## II. Organizational matters

### A. Adoption of the agenda

2. At its 1<sup>st</sup> meeting, the CMA considered document FCCC/PA/CMA/2022/1/Add.4 containing the provisional agenda. The President recalled the understanding reached among Parties outlined at the 1<sup>st</sup> plenary meeting of the Conference of the Parties at its twenty-seventh session. In addition, the President proposed to hold consultations on:

(a) The proposal from Zambia on behalf of the African Group on the special needs and special circumstances of Africa. The President proposed to report under agenda item 19, “Other matters”, on this and any other issues raised in the consultations;
