I. Opening of the session

(Agenda item 1)

1. The fifth session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement (CMA), convened pursuant to Article 16, paragraph 6, of the Paris Agreement, was held at Expo City Dubai in Dubai, United Arab Emirates, from 30 November to 12 December 2023. Sultan Ahmed Al Jaber (United Arab Emirates), President of CMA 5, convened the 1st meeting of the session¹ on Thursday, 30 November.²

2. At its 1st meeting, the CMA considered document FCCC/PA/CMA/2023/1/Add.3 containing the supplementary provisional agenda. The President recalled the understanding

9. At its resumed 1st meeting, on 30 November, the CMA adopted the decision entitled “Operationalization of the new funding arrangements, including a fund, for responding to loss and damage referred to in paragraphs 2–3 of decisions 2/CP.27 and 2/CMA.4”, contained in document FCCC/CP/2023/L.1–FCCC/PA/CMA/2023/L.1.

10. The President requested the secretariat to update paragraph 14 of the decision referred to in paragraph 9 above to reflect any offers made during the Conference to contribute to the

fund referred to in that decision. The President also requested the secretariat to make available on the UNFCCC website all offers to contribute as they are made.

11. The President encouraged Parties to nominate members and alternate members of the Board of the Fund during the Conference so that the Board could immediately be operational and serve the developing country Parties that are particularly vulnerable to the adverse effects of climate change.

12. The President recommended that, once operational, the Board take up the matter of naming the fund referred to in the above-mentioned decision.
