I. Introduction

1. On 13 October 2025, the secretariat received a request from Honduras, Papua New Guinea and Suriname to include an item in the provisional agenda for the seventh session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement (CMA).¹
