I. Opening of the session

(Agenda item 1)

1. The seventh meeting of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement (CMA), convened pursuant to Article 16, paragraph 6, of the Paris Agreement, was held at the Hangar Convention and Fair Centre of the Amazon in Belém, Brazil, from 10 to 21 November 2025. André Aranha Corrêa do Lago (Brazil), President of CMA 7, convened the 1st meeting of the session on 10 November.


II. Organizational matters

A. Adoption of the agenda

(Agenda sub-item 2(a))

2. At its 1st meeting, the CMA considered document FCCC/PA/CMA/2025/1/Add.3, containing the supplementary provisional agenda. The President recalled the understanding reached among Parties with regard to the adoption of the agendas for the sessions of the governing bodies outlined at the resumed 1st meeting of the Conference of the Parties (COP) at its thirtieth session.³

- 3. The President proposed that the supplementary provisional agenda for CMA 7 be amended to reflect this understanding, with sub-item 7(b) and items 18–22 deleted.

- 7. The President informed the CMA that the secretariat had prepared an update of the synthesis report on the nationally determined contributions.⁷
