I. Opening of the session

(Agenda item 1)

1. The sixteenth session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP), convened pursuant to Article 13, paragraph 6, of the Kyoto Protocol, was held at the Scottish Event Campus in Glasgow, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, from 31 October to 12 November 2021. Alok Sharma (United Kingdom), President of CMP 16, convened the 1st meeting of the session¹ on Sunday, 31 October.²

² CMP 16 was held in conjunction with the twenty-sixth session of the Conference of the Parties (COP) and the third session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Paris Agreement (CMA). The proceedings of the COP and the CMA are contained in separate reports. The proceedings of the joint meetings of the CMP, the COP and the CMA convened at the sessions are contained in the report of the COP and cross-referenced in the reports of the CMP and the CMA.

2. At its 1st meeting, the CMP considered document FCCC/KP/CMP/2021/1/Add.1 containing the provisional agenda.³ The President recalled the understanding reached among Parties outlined at the 1st plenary meeting of the Conference of the Parties (COP) at its twenty-sixth session.

3. Following a request by Ukraine,⁴ the President proposed and the CMP agreed to defer consideration of agenda sub-item 4(b), “Annual compilation and accounting report for the second commitment period for Annex B Parties under the Kyoto Protocol (for 2019, 2020 and 2021)”, to CMP 17 (November 2022).

4. On the proposal by the President, the CMP adopted the agenda as follows:

7. On a proposal by the President, the CMP agreed to refer agenda sub-item 4(c), “Date of completion of the expert review process under Article 8 of the Kyoto Protocol for the second commitment period”, to SBI 56 (June 2022) for consideration. The President

requested the SBI to conclude the work with a view to recommending a draft decision for consideration and adoption at CMP 17 at the latest.

8. The President noted that the CMP would reconvene during the second week of the session to consider the decisions and conclusions for adoption.
