I. Opening of the session

(Agenda item 1)

1. The seventeenth session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP), convened pursuant to Article 13, paragraph 6, of the Kyoto Protocol, was held at the Sharm el-Sheikh International Convention Center in Sharm el-Sheikh, Egypt, from 6 to 18 November 2022. Sameh Shoukry (Egypt), President of CMP 17, convened the 1st meeting of the session¹ on Sunday, 6 November.²

2. At its 1st meeting, the CMP considered document FCCC/KP/CMP/2022/1 containing the provisional agenda.

On a proposal by the President, the CMP agreed to defer consideration of the following matters under agenda item 4, “Reporting from and review of Parties included in Annex I”, to CMP 18 (November 2023): national communications, and the annual compilation and accounting report for the second commitment period for Annex B Parties under the Kyoto Protocol (for 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022).

6. The President informed the CMP that the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice and the Subsidiary Body for Implementation may recommend draft decisions or conclusions for consideration and adoption by the CMP under the following items on matters already on their agendas:

Item 8	Capacity-building under the Kyoto Protocol
Item 9	Report of the forum on the impact of the implementation of response measures
Item 12	Administrative, financial and institutional matters

7. The President noted that the CMP would reconvene during the second week of the session to consider the decisions and conclusions for adoption.
