- 3. Action: The CMP will be invited to adopt its agenda.

- 4. *Background*: If any member of the Bureau represents a State that is not a Party to the Kyoto Protocol, consultations will be required to identify a nominee representing a Party to the Kyoto Protocol to replace such a member in accordance with Article 13, paragraph 3, of the Kyoto Protocol. Parties are invited to recall decision <u>3/CP.23</u> and actively consider nominating women.

- (b) <u>Final compilation and accounting reports for the second commitment period of the Kyoto Protocol for Parties included in Annex I with a commitment inscribed in the third column of Annex B in the Doha Amendment to the Kyoto Protocol</u>
  - 16. *Background*: CMP 1 requested the secretariat to publish, after the additional period for fulfilling commitments, final compilation and accounting reports and to forward them to the CMP, the Compliance Committee and each Party concerned.<sup>7</sup>
  - 17. *Action*: The CMP will be invited to take note of the information contained in the final compilation and accounting reports and to take any action it deems appropriate.

# 5. Matters relating to the clean development mechanism

- 18. *Background*: The CDM Executive Board submits an annual report on its activities to the CMP.<sup>8</sup>
- 19. CMP 18 requested the secretariat to prepare technical papers on the necessary operations of the CDM registry and on the necessary level of resources for the functioning and operation of the processes and institutions under the CDM for consideration at SBSTA 60.9 SBSTA 60 requested the secretariat to prepare a technical paper on the further breakdown of the necessary level of resources for the activities, processes and institutions that need to continue under the CDM for consideration at SBSTA 61.10 Matters relating to this agenda item are considered under the SBSTA.11
- 20. At CMP 18, Parties decided to continue consideration of the functioning and operation of the processes and institutions under the CDM, including appropriate time frames, at CMP 19 with a view to avoiding a gap before the operationalization of the corresponding processes under the mechanism established by Article 6, paragraph 4, of the Paris Agreement.<sup>12</sup>
- 21. CMP 18 decided to authorize a transfer from the trust fund for the clean development mechanism to the Adaptation Fund and potentially to other areas in need of funding at CMP 19.<sup>13</sup>
- 22. Action: The CMP will be invited to consider the annual report of the CDM Executive Board and to continue consideration of the functioning and operation of the processes and institutions under the CDM, and to provide guidance relating to the CDM, as appropriate. The CMP will also be invited to elect members and alternate members of the CDM Executive Board. The CMP will further be invited to take any action it deems appropriate on the basis of the recommendations of the SBSTA.

# 6. Matters relating to the Adaptation Fund

- 23. *Background*: The AFB submits an annual report on its activities to the CMP.<sup>14</sup> CMP 18 and CMA 5 requested the AFB to include in its annual report to CMP 19 and CMA 6 information on the rates of use of the increased cap on allocation per country and encouraged the AFB to report on its work related to implementing its mandates from decisions <u>1/CMP.14</u> and <u>13/CMA.1</u> in its annual report to CMP 19 and CMA 6.<sup>15</sup>
- 24. CMP 16 requested the SBI to continue consideration of matters relating to membership of the AFB further to paragraph 5 of decision <u>1/CMP.14</u> and to forward a recommendation to the CMP for consideration at its next session.<sup>16</sup>
- 25. *Action*: The CMP will be invited to consider the annual report of the AFB, to provide guidance to the AFB and to take any action it deems appropriate. It will also be invited to elect members and alternate members of the AFB.

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# 8. Report of the forum on the impact of the implementation of response measures

28. *Background*: CMP 14, COP 24 and CMA 1 acknowledged that a single forum on the impact of the implementation of response measures covers the work of the CMP, the COP and the CMA on all matters relating to the impact of the implementation of response measures and affirmed that the forum shall report to the CMP, the COP and the CMA.<sup>18</sup>

- 29. CMA 1 decided that the forum shall provide recommendations for consideration by the subsidiary bodies with a view to them recommending actions for consideration and adoption by the CMP, the COP and the CMA.<sup>19</sup>
- 30. CMP 18, COP 28 and CMA 5 adopted the updated functions, work programme and modalities of the forum and its Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures and requested the Committee to propose updates to its rules of procedure for the forum to consider and make recommendations to the subsidiary bodies with a view to the subsidiary bodies providing recommendations for consideration and adoption at CMP 19, COP 29 and CMA 6.<sup>20</sup>
- 31. At SB 60, Parties agreed to continue developing the five-year workplan of the forum and its Katowice Committee on Impacts at SB 61 with a view to recommending a draft decision for consideration and adoption at CMP 19, COP 29 and CMA 6.<sup>21</sup>
- 32. Matters relating to this agenda item are considered under the SBSTA and the SBI.<sup>22</sup>
- 33. *Action*: The CMP will be invited to take any action it deems appropriate on the basis of the recommendations of the SBSTA and the SBI.

# 10. Report on the high-level ministerial round table on increased ambition of Kyoto Protocol commitments

- 36. *Background*: CMP 8 adopted the Doha Amendment to the Kyoto Protocol, establishing a second commitment period of the Kyoto Protocol.<sup>24</sup> A high-level ministerial round table was held on 5 June 2014, at which information was considered on the intention of Parties included in Annex I with commitments in the second commitment period to increase the ambition of their mitigation commitments. A report on the round table was prepared for consideration at CMP 10.<sup>25</sup>
- 37. CMP 10 to 18 could not complete consideration of this matter.<sup>26</sup> Pursuant to rules 10(c) and 16 of the draft rules of procedure being applied, this matter has been included in the provisional agenda for CMP 19.
