I. Introduction

1. On 6 November 2024 the secretariat received a request from China on behalf of Brazil, South Africa, India and China (BASIC countries) to include an item in the provisional agenda for the nineteenth session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP).¹

2. In accordance with rule 12 of the draft rules of procedure being applied, and in agreement with the President of CMP 18, this matter has been included in the supplementary provisional agenda as item 11.

II. Supplementary provisional agenda

3. The supplementary provisional agenda for CMP 19, proposed after consultation with the President of CMP 18, is as follows:
