I. Opening of the session

(Agenda item 1)

1. The twentieth session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP), convened pursuant to Article 13, paragraph 6, of the Kyoto Protocol, was held at the Hangar Convention and Fair Centre of the Amazon in Belém, Brazil, from 10 to 21 November 2025.¹ André Aranha Corrêa do Lago (Brazil), President of CMP 20, convened the 1st meeting of the session² on 10 November.

II. Organizational matters

A. Adoption of the agenda

(Agenda sub-item 2(a))

2. At its 1st meeting, the CMP considered document FCCC/KP/CMP/2025/1, containing the provisional agenda. The President recalled the understanding reached among Parties with regard to the adoption of the agendas for the sessions of the governing bodies outlined at the resumed 1st meeting of the Conference of the Parties at its thirtieth session.³

3. The President proposed that the provisional agenda for CMP 20 be amended to reflect this understanding, with items 12–13 deleted.
4. On the proposal by the President, the CMP adopted the agenda as follows:

 - (b) Report of the Subsidiary Body for Implementation.
 4. Reporting from and review of Parties included in Annex I:⁴ national communications.

 6. Matters relating to the Adaptation Fund.
 7. Matters relating to capacity-building.
 8. Report of the forum on the impact of the implementation of response measures.
 9. Report of the Compliance Committee.
 10. Report on the high-level ministerial round table on increased ambition of Kyoto Protocol commitments (*deferred to CMP 21*).
 11. Administrative, financial and institutional matters.
 12. High-level segment:
 - (a) Statements by Parties;
 - (b) Statements by observer organizations.

5. At its 1st meeting, on a proposal by the President, the CMP agreed to follow the organization of work agreed at the 1st meeting of the Conference of the Parties (COP) at its thirtieth session.⁵

6. The President noted that the subsidiary bodies would conclude their work by 15 November and that he looked forward to hearing the outcomes of their sessions.
