- 4. *Background:* If any member of the Bureau represents a State that is not a Party to the Kyoto Protocol, consultations will be required to identify a nominee representing a Party to the Kyoto Protocol to replace such a member in accordance with Article 13, paragraph 3, of the Kyoto Protocol. Parties are invited to recall, inter alia, decisions [23/CP.18](#), [3/CP.23](#) and [7/CP.29](#) and actively consider nominating women.
- 5. *Action:* The CMP will be invited, as necessary, to elect additional members of the Bureau.

(b) Report of the Subsidiary Body for Implementation

13. *Background:* The Chair of the SBI, Julia Gardiner (Australia), will report on the work conducted at SBI 64 and 65, including any recommendations of draft decisions and conclusions for consideration and adoption at CMP 21.

14. SBI 64 recommended draft decisions on the fifth comprehensive review of the implementation of the framework for capacity-building in developing countries under the Kyoto Protocol and the sixth review of the implementation of the framework for capacity-building in countries with economies in transition under the Kyoto Protocol respectively for consideration and adoption at CMP 21.^{8, 9}

15. *Action:* The CMP will be invited to take note of the progress in the work of the SBI and consider the recommended draft decisions and conclusions for adoption.

4. Reporting from and review of Parties included in Annex I: national communications

16. *Background:* SBI 61 considered the note by the secretariat on the status of submission and review of national communications and biennial reports¹⁰ and took note of the information therein.¹¹

17. As at the time of preparation of this document, the secretariat had not received any eighth national communications from Parties included in Annex I additional to those covered in the above-mentioned status report.

18. *Action:* The CMP will be invited to note the information referred to in paragraph 17 above.

19. *Background:* The CDM Executive Board submits an annual report on its activities to the CMP.¹²

20. *Action:* The CMP will be invited to consider the 2026 report of the CDM Executive Board and provide guidance relating to the CDM, as appropriate. The CMP will also be invited to elect members and alternate members of the CDM Executive Board.

6. Matters relating to the Adaptation Fund

21. *Background:* The AFB submits an annual report on its activities to the CMP.¹³

22. CMP 16 requested the SBI to continue consideration of matters relating to the membership of the AFB and forward a recommendation for consideration at CMP 17.¹⁴

23. CMP 17 also requested SBI 62 to initiate the fifth review of the AF and report back to its governing bodies at the sessions to be convened in conjunction with COP 31.¹⁵

24. CMP 19 and CMA 6 further requested SBI 62 to consider the matter of the arrangements for the AF to exclusively serve the Paris Agreement and to make recommendations thereon for consideration at CMP 20 and CMA 7 respectively.¹⁶

25. SBI 62 agreed that SBI 63 would continue consideration of matters relating to the membership of the AFB, the arrangements for the AF to exclusively serve the Paris Agreement and the initiation of the fifth review of the AF.¹⁷ SBI 63 could not conclude consideration thereof and agreed to forward the matters to CMP 20 and CMA 7 for

consideration.¹⁸ CMP 20 and CMA 7 requested SBI 64 to continue consideration of the matters.¹⁹

26. SBI 64 agreed that SBI 65 will continue consideration of these matters on the basis of the work and progress achieved at SBI 64 and the draft texts available on the UNFCCC website.^{20, 21} Accordingly, matters relating to the AF are considered under the SBI.²²

27. *Action:* The CMP will be invited to consider the 2026 report of the AFB, provide guidance to the AFB and take any other action it deems appropriate, including on the basis of the recommendations of the SBI. It will also be invited to elect members and alternate members of the AFB.

7. Report of the forum on the impact of the implementation of response measures

28. *Background:* CMP 14, COP 24 and CMA 1 acknowledged that a single forum on the impact of the implementation of response measures covers the work of the CMP, the COP and the CMA on all matters relating to the impact of the implementation of response measures and affirmed that the forum shall report to the CMP, the COP and the CMA.²³

29. CMP 19, COP 29 and CMA 6 adopted the workplan of the forum and its KCI for 2026–2030.²⁴

30. CMP 20, COP 30 and CMA 7 requested the KCI to present, at the second regular sessions of the subsidiary bodies each year, its annual report and key findings therefrom to the forum for consideration with a view to the forum making recommendations for consideration by the CMP, the COP and the CMA.²⁵

31. SB 64 convened a meeting of the forum but could not conclude consideration of this matter and agreed that SB 65 will continue consideration of the matter.²⁶ CMP 20, COP 30 and CMA 7 decided that the forum will conduct the activities referred to in paragraph 11 of decisions [2/CMP.20](#), [6/CP.30](#) and [14/CMA.7](#) at SB 65.²⁷ Accordingly, matters relating to this agenda item are considered under the SBSTA and the SBI.²⁸

32. *Action:* The CMP will be invited to take any action it deems appropriate on the basis of the recommendations of the SBSTA and the SBI.

9. Report on the high-level ministerial round table on increased ambition of Kyoto Protocol commitments

36. *Background:* CMP 8 adopted the Doha Amendment to the Kyoto Protocol, establishing a second commitment period of the Kyoto Protocol.³¹ A high-level ministerial round table was held on 5 June 2014, at which information was considered on the intention of Parties included in Annex I with commitments in the second commitment period to increase the ambition of their mitigation commitments. A report on the round table was prepared for consideration at CMP 10.³²

37. CMP 10 to 19 could not conclude consideration of this matter.³³ CMP 20 agreed to defer consideration of this matter to CMP 21.³⁴

38. *Action:* The CMP will be invited to continue consideration of this matter and take any action it deems appropriate.

10. Administrative, financial and institutional matters

39. *Background:* Matters relating to this agenda item are considered under the SBI.³⁵

40. SBI 64 recommended a draft decision on administrative, financial and institutional matters for consideration and adoption at CMP 21.³⁶

41. *Action:* The CMP will be invited to take any action it deems appropriate on the basis of the recommendations of the SBI.
