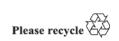
Supplementary provisional agenda

I. Introduction

- 1. On 4 November 2022, the secretariat received a request from Pakistan on behalf of the Group of 77 and China to include an item in the provisional agenda for the twenty-seventh session of the Conference of the Parties (COP).¹
- 2. In accordance with rule 12 of the draft rules of procedure being applied, and in agreement with the President of COP 26, this matter has been included in the supplementary agenda as item 20.

II. Supplementary provisional agenda

- 3. The supplementary provisional agenda for COP 27, proposed after consultation with the President of COP 26, is as follows:
 - 1. Opening of the session.
 - 2. Organizational matters:
 - (a) Election of the President of the Conference of the Parties at its twentyseventh session;
 - (b) Adoption of the rules of procedure;
 - (c) Adoption of the agenda;
 - (d) Election of officers other than the President;
 - (e) Admission of organizations as observers;

- (g) Dates and venues of future sessions;
- (h) Adoption of the report on credentials.

 - (b) Report of the Subsidiary Body for Implementation.
- 4. Reporting from and review of Parties included in Annex I to the Convention.

 - (a) Report of the Adaptation Committee;
