Supplementary provisional agenda

I. Introduction

1. On 9 November 2025, the secretariat received a request from Zimbabwe to include an item in the provisional agenda for the thirtieth session of the Conference of the Parties (COP).¹
2. Also on 9 November 2025, the secretariat received a request from Kyrgyzstan to include an item in the provisional agenda for COP 30.²
3. In accordance with rule 12 of the draft rules of procedure being applied, and in agreement with the President of COP 29, these matters have been included in the supplementary provisional agenda as items 20 and 21 respectively, in the order in which the respective requests were received.

II. Supplementary provisional agenda

4. The supplementary provisional agenda for COP 30, proposed after consultation with the President of COP 29, is as follows:
