Agenda item 3 (e) Methodological issues Issues relating to Articles 7 and 8 of the Kyoto Protocol

Draft conclusions proposed by the co-chairs of the contact group on agenda item 3 (e)

- 1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) considered ways of providing expert review teams with access to confidential inventory information of Parties included in Annex I to the Convention during periods when the team is neither in the country under review nor at the offices of the secretariat. The SBSTA decided to recommend a decision on this matter (FCCC/SBSTA/2004/L.7/Add.1) for adoption by the Conference of the Parties (COP) at its tenth session, including a draft decision to be forwarded to the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol at its first session.
- 2. The SBSTA considered text to incorporate the modalities and procedures for afforestation and reforestation project activities under the clean development mechanism agreed in decision 19/CP.9 into the relevant sections of the guidelines under Articles 7 and 8 of the Kyoto Protocol. The SBSTA decided to recommend a decision on this matter (FCCC/SBSTA/2004/L.7/Add.2) for adoption by the COP at its tenth session.
