Provision of financial and technical support

Revised draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) considered document FCCC/SBI/2005/INF.8 containing a list of projects identified in national communications by Parties not included in Annex I to the Convention (non-Annex I Parties) in accordance with Article 12, paragraph 4, of the Convention.
2. The SBI noted its request under agenda item 4 (a) to the Consultative Group of Experts on National Communications from Parties not included in Annex I to the Convention (CGE) to make recommendations on ways to improve the reporting of projects identified in their national communications in accordance with Article 12, paragraph 4, of the Convention, to report on ways to improve access to financial and technical support for such projects, and to advise the SBI on this matter at its twenty-sixth session (June 2007).
3. The SBI invited bilateral and multilateral assistance programmes to provide support to non-Annex I Parties in formulating and developing project proposals identified in their national communications in accordance with Article 12, paragraph 4, of the Convention, and in their subsequent implementation.
4. The SBI encouraged non-Annex I Parties to submit their project proposals to the Global Environment Facility through its implementing agencies, and to bilateral and multilateral assistance programmes, for timely funding.
