Training programme for reviewers under Article 8 of the Kyoto Protocol

Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) took note of the oral report by the secretariat on progress in implementation of the training programme for members of expert review teams participating in review activities under the Kyoto Protocol. It further noted that the training programme, comprising modules on national systems under Article 5, paragraph 1, of the Kyoto Protocol, on adjustments under Article 5, paragraph 2, of the Kyoto Protocol, and on the accounting of assigned amounts under Article 7, paragraph 4, of the Kyoto Protocol, was made available online to members of expert review teams.
2. The SBSTA requested Parties to nominate experts to the above-mentioned training programme to support the review process under the Kyoto Protocol.
3. The SBSTA requested the secretariat, in accordance with decision 24/CMP.1, to report to the SBSTA, at its twenty-fifth session (November 2006), on progress in the implementation of the training programme.
