Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) encouraged the constituted bodies established under the Kyoto Protocol to review their rules of procedure relating to breaches of conditions of service, taking rule 4 of the rules of procedure of the Compliance Committee as point of reference.
2. The SBI decided to recommend a draft decision on this subject for adoption by the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol at its fourth session (for the text of the decision, see FCCC/SBI/2008/L.20/Add.1)
