Scientific, technical and socio-economic aspects of mitigation of climate change

Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) took note of views of Parties on possible future work on scientific, technical and socio-economic aspects of mitigation of climate change.¹

2. The SBSTA agreed that its work under this agenda item to date, including the in-session workshops, has facilitated useful and informative exchanges of information and views among Parties and practitioners.

3. The SBSTA recognized that the work and negotiations on the comprehensive post-2012 climate agreement under decision 1/CP.13 (the Bali Action Plan) address mitigation.

4. The SBSTA agreed, noting the usefulness of working in a manner that is conducive to enhanced interaction among Parties, to consider this issue, taking into account the best available scientific information on mitigation, including in particular information from the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change, at its thirty-second session (May–June 2010).
