# Provisional agenda and annotations

# I. Provisional agenda

## II. Background

1. By its decision 1/CP.13 (the Bali Action Plan), the Conference of the Parties (COP) launched a comprehensive process to enable the full, effective and sustained implementation of the Convention through long-term cooperative action, now, up to and beyond 2012, in order to reach an agreed outcome and adopt a decision at its fifteenth session. It decided that the process shall be conducted under a subsidiary body under the Convention, the Ad Hoc Working Group on Long-term Cooperative Action under the Convention (AWG-LCA).

- 2. The COP, by its decision 1/CP.15, extended the mandate of the AWG-LCA to enable it to continue its work with a view to presenting the outcome of its work to the COP for adoption at its sixteenth session. At the same session, the COP requested the AWG-LCA to continue its work, drawing on the report of the AWG-LCA presented to the COP at its fifteenth session, as well as work undertaken by the COP on the basis of that report.<sup>1</sup>
- 3. At its ninth session, the AWG-LCA agreed that its tenth session would be held in conjunction with the thirty-second sessions of the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) and the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice. The AWG-LCA further agreed that its sessions would be held in conjunction with those of the Ad Hoc Working Group on Further Commitments for Annex I Parties under the Kyoto Protocol.<sup>2</sup>

# III. Annotations to the provisional agenda

4. The tenth session of the AWG-LCA will be opened by the Chair on Tuesday, 1 June 2010, at the Maritim Hotel in Bonn, Germany.

- 6. *Background*: The Chair of the AWG-LCA has prepared a note (FCCC/AWGLCA/2010/5) on the scenario for the tenth session, taking account of the invitation by the AWG-LCA to propose an indicative roadmap as referred to in paragraph 13 below. Delegates are invited to consult this scenario note for further information and proposals on the organization of work.
- 7. The AWG-LCA will meet in an opening plenary on Tuesday, 1 June. The Chair will invite statements, starting with statements on behalf of groups of Parties. Delegations are requested to keep their oral statements as brief as possible and to provide a hard copy to the conference officers in advance to facilitate the work of the interpreters. Those wishing to make a written statement available to all delegates should bring copies for distribution.
- 8. Parties are invited to refer to the overview of the session posted on the UNFCCC website and to consult the Daily Programme, published during the session, for a detailed and up-to-date schedule of the work of the AWG-LCA.
- 9. The SBI, at its twenty-fourth session,<sup>3</sup> recommended that meetings should normally end by 6 p.m. but may, in exceptional circumstances, continue no later than 9 p.m. This session of the AWG-LCA will be organized accordingly.
- 10. Action: The AWG-LCA will be invited to agree on the organization of work for the session.

- 3. Preparation of an outcome to be presented to the Conference of the Parties for adoption at its sixteenth session to enable the full, effective and sustained implementation of the Convention through long-term cooperative action now, up to and beyond 2012
- 11. *Background*: The AWG-LCA at its ninth session invited its Chair to prepare, under her own responsibility, a text to facilitate negotiations among Parties, drawing on the report of the AWG-LCA presented to the COP at its fifteenth session,<sup>4</sup> as well as work undertaken by the COP on the basis of that report, and to make this text available two weeks in advance of the tenth session of the AWG-LCA.<sup>5</sup> This text is contained in document FCCC/AWGLCA/2010/6. The Chair will introduce the text to delegates during the opening plenary.
- 12. At the same session, the AWG-LCA invited Parties to make submissions containing additional views, which the Chair may draw upon in the preparation of her draft text for consideration by Parties at its tenth session. The submissions received are contained in document FCCC/AWGLCA/2010/MISC.2.
- 13. The AWG-LCA, at its ninth session, also invited its Chair to propose, through her scenario notes, an indicative roadmap, and invited Parties to submit to the secretariat their views on this matter. The submissions received have been compiled into document FCCC/AWGLCA/2010/MISC.3.
- 14. *Action*: The AWG-LCA will be invited to continue its negotiations of the outcome to be presented to the COP for adoption at its sixteenth session.
