### Matters relating to Article 2, paragraph 3, of the Kyoto Protocol

#### Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) and the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) considered the synthesis of information and views on issues that will be addressed at the joint workshop<sup>1</sup> on matters relating to Article 2, paragraph 3, and Article 3, paragraph 14, of the Kyoto Protocol.<sup>2</sup>
2. The SBSTA and the SBI recalled their request to the secretariat to organize the joint workshop and encouraged Parties in a position to do so to provide support to the secretariat in organizing the workshop, with a view to maximizing participation, before their thirty-fifth sessions.
3. The SBSTA and the SBI identified issues that will be addressed at their joint workshop on matters referred to in paragraph 1 above, including inter alia:
  - (a) Sharing information to enhance understanding of adverse effects, including the adverse effects of climate change, effects on international trade, and social, environmental and economic impacts;
  - (b) Minimizing the adverse effects through a process to implement Article 2, paragraph 3, and Article 3, paragraph 14, of the Kyoto Protocol:
    - (i) Further implementation of decision 31/CMP.1;
    - (ii) Research and assessment;
    - (iii) Enhancing support to developing country Parties, particularly those identified in Article 4, paragraphs 8 and 9, of the Convention;
    - (iv) Enhancing reporting and verification.

4. The SBSTA and the SBI agreed to continue to discuss matters related to Article 2, paragraph 3, and Article 3, paragraph 14, of the Kyoto Protocol, including consideration of the workshop report in a joint contact group to be established by them at their thirty-fifth sessions.
