Work programme on clarification of quantified economy-wide emission reduction targets of developed country Parties

Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) initiated the work programme on clarification of quantified economy-wide emission reduction targets of developed country Parties, in accordance with decision 1/CP.18, paragraph 8. The considerations of the SBSTA were informed by views submitted by Parties.¹
2. The SBSTA welcomed the information that was exchanged during the in-session event on quantified economy-wide emission reduction targets of developed country Parties and expressed its appreciation to the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development, the South Centre and the World Resources Institute for their presentations. The SBSTA expressed its appreciation to Parties for sharing information and their views. The SBSTA noted that the co-facilitators prepared, under their own responsibility, a note² containing their reflections on the discussions in the informal consultations during the session. The information contained in the note is not an exhaustive list of issues and options discussed, was not negotiated by Parties, nor does it reflect conclusions by the Parties. Parties may wish to consider the note for continuation of the discussions at SBSTA 39 (November 2013).
3. The SBSTA agreed to continue its consideration of this matter at SBSTA 39, with a view to reporting on the progress of the work programme referred to in paragraph 1 above to the Conference of the Parties at its nineteenth session (November 2013).
