Capacity-building under the Kyoto Protocol

Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) welcomed the success of the 2nd and 3rd meetings of the Durban Forum for in-depth discussion on capacity-building, held during SBI 38 and 40.
2. The SBI expressed its appreciation to Parties and representatives of intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations and the private sector for their active participation in the 2nd and 3rd meetings of the Durban Forum and for the sharing of experiences and exchanging of ideas, best practices and lessons learned regarding the implementation of capacity-building activities related to the implementation of the Kyoto Protocol.
3. The SBI welcomed the launch of the UNFCCC Capacity-building Portal.¹
4. The SBI continued, but did not conclude, its consideration of capacity-building for developing countries under the Kyoto Protocol. It agreed to continue its consideration of the matter at SBI 41 (December 2014) on the basis of the draft decision text contained in the annex to document FCCC/SBI/2013/L.18/Rev.1, with a view to recommending a draft decision for consideration and adoption by the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol at its tenth session (December 2014).
