Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

- 1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) continued its discussion of the issue of procedures, mechanisms and institutional arrangements for appeals against the decisions of the Executive Board of the clean development mechanism, in accordance with the mandate set out in decision 3/CMP.6, paragraph 18.
- 2. The SBI agreed to continue its consideration of this matter on the basis of, inter alia, the co-facilitators' draft text contained in document FCCC/SBI/2012/33/Add.1 at SBI 42 (June 2015), with a view to recommending a draft decision for consideration and adoption by the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol at its twelfth session (November–December 2016).
