National adaptation plans

Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) welcomed the information submitted by Parties on their experiences with the application of the initial guidelines for the formulation of national adaptation plans (NAPs) as well as information relevant to the formulation and implementation of NAPs provided by Parties and relevant organizations through their submissions.¹
2. The SBI also welcomed the documents prepared for the session, including the following:
 - (a) Information paper on experiences, good practices, lessons learned, gaps and needs in the process to formulate and implement national adaptation plans;²
 - (b) Information paper on the national adaptation plan process.³
3. The SBI recommended a draft decision on national adaptation plans for consideration and adoption by the Conference of the Parties at its twentieth session (for the text of the draft decision, see document FCCC/SBI/2014/L.42/Add.1).
