## Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

- 2. The SBSTA noted the information collected through submissions from Parties in the course of the consideration of this agenda sub-item, as contained in documents FCCC/SBSTA/2011/MISC.12, FCCC/SBSTA/2011/INF.15, FCCC/SBSTA/2012/MISC.10 and FCCC/SBSTA/2014/CRP.2.
- 3. The SBSTA invited Parties to submit their further views on this matter via the submissions portal<sup>1</sup> by 9 March 2016.
- 4. The SBSTA agreed to continue its consideration of this matter at SBSTA 44 (May 2016) with a view to reporting on the outcomes of that consideration to the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol at its twelfth session (November 2016).
