Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) continued its consideration of the work programmes referred to in decision 2/CMP.7, paragraphs 5, 6, 7 and 10.

2. The SBSTA acknowledged with appreciation the rich exchange of views by Parties that took place during the in-session workshop on revegetation activities and requested the secretariat to prepare a report on the workshop for consideration at SBSTA 45 (November 2016).

3. The SBSTA agreed to continue its consideration of the work programme referred to in decision 2/CMP.7, paragraph 6, at SBSTA 45, with a view to recommending a draft decision on the matter for consideration and adoption by the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP) at CMP 12 (November 2016), as reflected in document FCCC/SBSTA/2016/CRP.1.

4. The SBSTA also agreed to continue its consideration of the work programmes referred to in decision 2/CMP.7, paragraphs 5, 7 and 10, at SBSTA 45, with a view to recommending a draft decision or reporting on the outcomes, for consideration and, as appropriate, adoption at CMP 12.
